The Actual Sebha University was initially instituted as a Faculty of letter affiliated to the university Tripoli and by decree No. 187/1983 it became an independent university, beginning with two faculties (faculty of Sciences – Faculty of Education), and later on the number of faculties reach 21 faculties located in various areas in the south of Libya (Sebha, Braak, Murzuq, Taragen, Zawila, Ubari, Ghat). The number of students in Sebha University is (25920) students.

Sebha University awards Bachelor Degree, Master's Degree, Doctor of Philosophy (PhD).

- The university includes a number of research centers and service units that provide support students and teaching staff members.
- The university issues a number of academic journals and periodicals in both English and Arabic. These journals and periodicals are meant to publish contributions of teaching staff members in the university to encourage doing scientific research and enrichment of knowledge.

- Meeting the needs of the community with those of scientific experiences and efficiency capable of interacting with community issues.

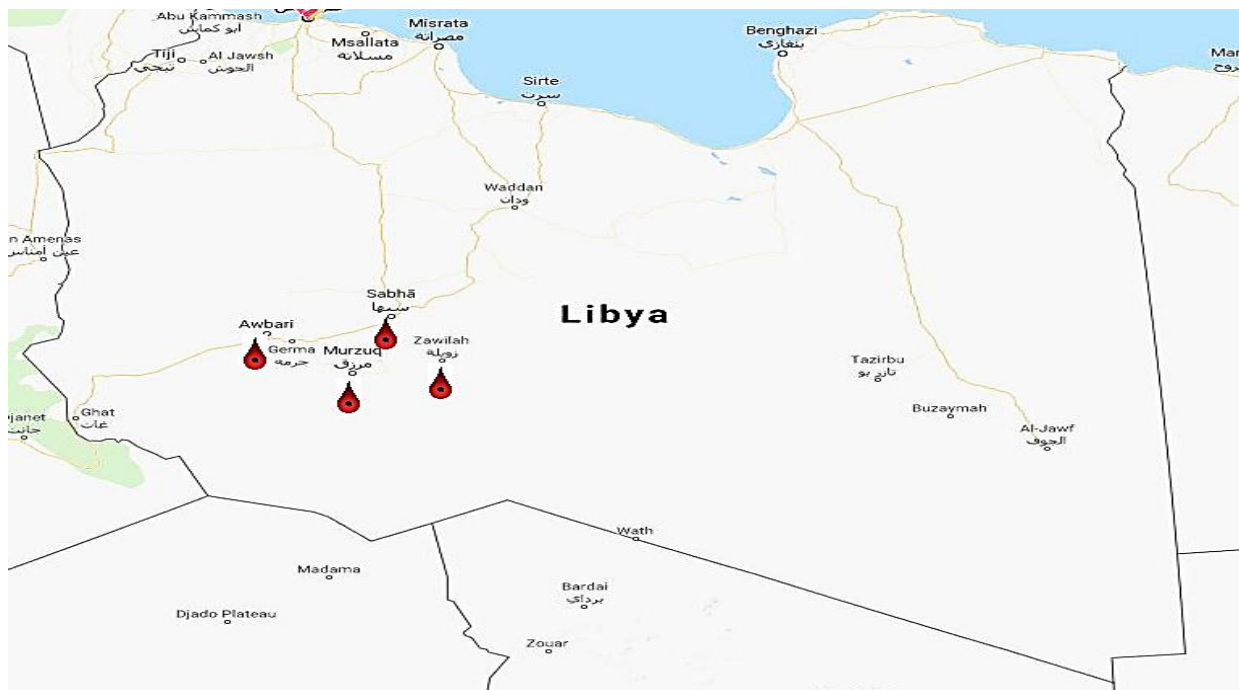
Objectives:
